Discover Creative Careers is the industry-led initiative addressing urgent challenges around future skills shortages within the creative economy – a challenge that must be tackled together to ensure we continue to thrive.

It is part of Government's pledge to build a highly-skilled, productive and inclusive workforce for the future, outlined in the <u>Creative Industries Sector Vision</u>.

The programme's hybrid events, opportunities and resources aim to inform and inspire young people in England aged 11-18 and those that support their careers decisions.

This includes the annual <u>Discover! Creative Careers Week</u> which offers industry-led activities to young people every November. Last year's activities saw thousands enjoy over 25,000 interactions with employers.
